## Grant funding for Townsville Rugby

The future of Townsville and District Rugby Union is looking brighter thanks to the upgrading of power supply to lighting at the playing fields on Hugh Street. By upgrading the underground power supply we have lengthened and improved the workability and safety of the power system enabling Townsville and District Rugby Union to light the fields for 10 or more years.

## The Answer 1

13.8 BALL GOES DIRECTLY INTO TOUCH

The ball must land in the field of play. If it is kicked directly into touch the opposing team has three choices:

- To have the ball kicked off again, or
- To have a scrum at the centre and they have the throw in, or
- To accept the kick.

If they accept the kick, the lineout is on the half-way line. If the ball is blown behind the half-way line and goes directly into touch, the lineout is at the place where it went into touch.

## The Answer 2

13.14 DROP OUT GOES DIRECTLY INTO TOUCH

The ball must land in the field of play.

If it is kicked directly into touch, the opposing team has three choices:

- To have another drop out, or
- To have a scrum at the centre of the 22-metre line, and they throw in the ball, or
- To accept the kick.

If they accept the kick, the throw in is on the 22-metre line.
