

Clubs to supply touch judges

At last weeks TDRU Council meeting it was resolved that as from July 1 this year, all clubs would provide a person to undertake the role of touch judge at each game in which the club is participating with the exception of A Grade games.

It was further resolved that the referees would provide a vest for these club volunteers to wear to distinguish them as a touch judge. The vests will be issued to the relevant persons by the referees prior to the game, at the same time they issue the touch judge flags.

The wearing of the vest is *mandatory*.

Due to the increase in the number of teams and limited number of referees this year the provision of club volunteers as touch judges has been necessary for the games to continue. Clubs have been active in providing a person to undertake the touch judge role. This initiative formalises the identification of club volunteer touch judges. If before 1 July a referee offers you a vest with the flag, you are urged to accept and wear it during the course of the game while you run the line.

The referees will also offer the opportunity for participants to attend a touch judge course.
