Tour Opportunity for Juniors

Six Townsville Junior Rugby Club teams are off to Bowen for their First rugby tour to play teams not in the Townsville Rugby Competition.

Charters Towers and Teachers West are each entering an Under 10 and Under 12 teams. Western Districts has entered an Under 12 team and Ross River Redskins have entered their Under 10s.

The TDRU's Terry Shiells, Reg Andison of Bowen and Peter Chengody from Whitsundays have organised a junior rugby carnival in Bowen on Sunday August 16, August 2009.

The age groups will be under 10's and under 12's, these teams would play as club teams, in club uniforms and coached and managed by club coaches.

On this weekend all games of the TDRU competition are played on the Friday night. Terry Shiells was happy to organise the tour from TDRU end.

The costs inclusive of travel and lunch would be just \$25 per player, with coaches and managers having no cost, travelling by bus.

The tour will leave Townsville at 7:00 am on Sunday the 16 August and return to the Hugh Street grounds at 6:00 pm.

This is an excellent chance for all clubs players to have a great experience playing against opposition from different centres, and also having their first rugby tour.

Deductions

The TDRU has recently had to deduct points from a club for playing an uncleared and unregistered player and is currently waiting on a response from another club to a show cause notice relating to a similar matter.

National Indigenous Championships

1 August 2009

Last week at Tullebudgera Outdoor Recreation Centre on the Gold Coast, six teams from around the country gathered for the Under 16 National Indigenous Championships. Teams from Northern New South Wales, Southern New South Wales and ACT, Northern Territory, North Queensland, Southern Queensland and Combined States took part in the tournament, which gives indigenous schoolboys the opportunity to play Rugby at a representative level.

The tournament had plenty of new talent on display and Qantas Wallaby Matt Hodgson (former player for Lloyd McDermott program) and Kurtley Beale were on hand to offer advice to the young players, along with former Aboriginal Wallabies Lloyd McDermott, Lloyd Walker and Gary Ella.

The final was a nail-biter between Southern Queensland and Northern Queensland, with the team from the north of the state coming away with the Championship trophy, winning 29-17.

The round-robin tournament is held annually and hosted by the Lloyd McDermott Rugby Development Team Inc (LMRDT) with assistance from ARU, ASC and participating Member Unions.

Each year, the National Indigenous Under 16 Team is selected from the Championship to compete at the Australian Rugby Union National Under 16s Championship in October.

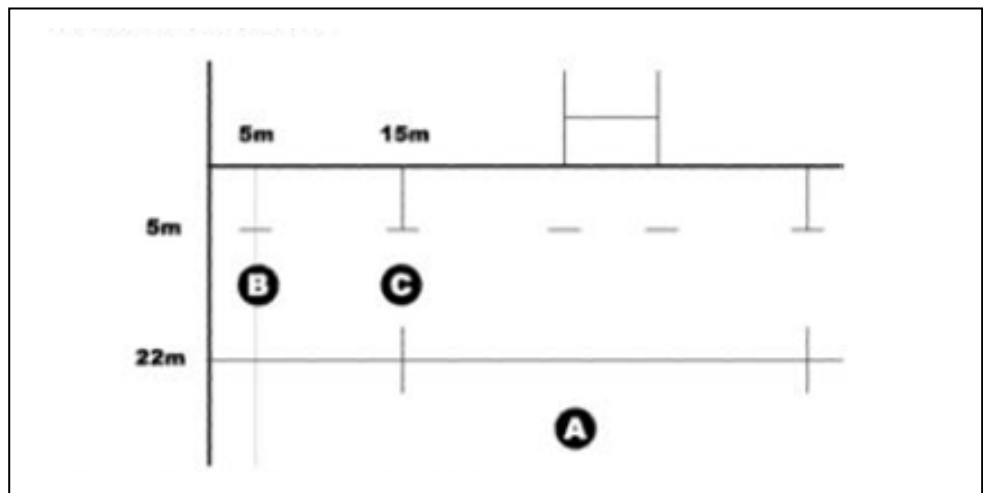

Law 10 Foul Play

10.4 DANGEROUS PLAY AND MISCONDUCT

(m) Late-charging the kicker. A player must not intentionally charge or obstruct an opponent who has just kicked the ball.

Penalty: The non-offending team may choose to take the penalty kick either at the place of infringement, where the ball lands, or where it was next played.

Place of infringement. If the infringement takes place in the kicker's in-goal, the penalty kick is taken 5 metres from the goal line in line with the place of infringement but at least 15 metres from the touchline.

The non-offending team may also choose to take the penalty kick where the ball lands or is next played and at least 15 metres from the touchline.

Where the ball lands. If the ball lands in touch, the mark for the optional penalty kick is on the 15-metre line, in line with where it went into touch. If the ball lands within 15 metres of the touchline, the mark is on the 15-metre line opposite where it landed.
