Brolgas win Anzac Day clash but Legacy the real winner

The inaugural ZINC Commemorative Challenge has been won by the Walters IGA Townsville Brolgas, who claimed a 14-13 win over the Queensland Army team at Hugh Street on Anzac Day. In the spirit of Anzac Day, however, the true winner from the event was Legacy, who will receive the proceeds raised by the local rugby union community.

A crowd of just over 500 gathered to watch both the main game and another between ladies teams from the Army and James Cook University. "It's the first time in quite some time that we've done something like this," TDRU spokesman Terry Shiells said, "So we are very happy with the results."

Before the main game, a condensed Anzac service was held. Once the formalities were taken care of, the focus turned to the battle of the main game. The Townsville Brolgas team that took to the field was a little different to the one named in the days leading up to the game. "There were club matches the day before so we had to make some changes due to a few issues," Shiells said.

The close result saw the crowd on the edge of their seats for the afternoon but the biggest achievement was the \$1,000 raised for Legacy. These funds will be used to support the families of defence force personnel who pay the ultimate sacrifice.

With the inaugural event was declared a success, Mr Shiells hopes it will become an annual event. "It's a great opportunity for the rugby union community to show our appreciation for the defence forces and to raise some money for a worthy charity," he said. "Hopefully we can make it bigger and better next year and in the years to come."

Open Schoolboys North Queensland Side

On the 26th of March the North Queensland Schoolboys Open side was selected to participate in the Queensland Rugby Football Schools Union State Championships beginning on the 26th of May at Sunnybank Rugby Club in Brisbane. Head Coach John Rauch said they have a stronger team than in previous years with the bulk of the team having travelled to Japan over Easter. "The tour to Japan is a great learning curve to prepare for these championships and it will serve the boys well at the competition" Rauch said.

The team has been placed in Pool A for the round matches and will face stiff opposition from South Coast, Sunshine Coast, Capricornia and Met West. Northern last won the Title on the Gold Coast in 2004 and had 7 players selected in the Combined Secondary Schools team. This Northern team will have high hopes of getting players selected, "there is definitely a lot of players in this team that are up to this standard and have an opportunity to get picked at the next level" Rauch said.

The team will train every Sunday until they depart on the 25th of May
